bhagavad-gītā – a mother who is also a guru

She holds our hands and compassionately guides us to the 'Truth.' She caresses us with her knowledge, nourishes us with her wisdom, and protects us from all kinds of fears of life. She teaches us to play the game of life, and is by our side all the time till we succeed.

In a world of no guarantees, the only thing that is guaranteed are the words of Lord Krishna when He says – "Be with me and you shall succeed. There is no doubt about it."

Do you have any fear? Refer to the bhagavad-qītā

There are different kinds of fears:

- Fear of losing things that we are so attached to or people whom we so love
- Fear of the future that holds so many uncertainties
- Fear of facing the end of this earthly surgeon

All these fears can be overcome by the central message of *bhagavad-gītā* which says, **"You are the Dehi – the indweller; You are not the Deha – the body."**



To Share is My Joy

I have experienced, enjoyed and benefitted from understanding and practicing the scriptures, especially the *bhagavad-gītā*, and I know that this can benefit everybody around the world. This is what is needed at this point of time to change the world.

A limpid stream of sublime spiritual wisdom flowed, touched and nourished the thirst of parched hearts, and filled in those empty spaces in their hearts that longed for love, and emptied those spaces in their hearts that yearned for cleansing.

The source of this stream is a storehouse of perennial pure wisdom. How can one describe this source – the Krishna of the *dwāpara yuga*, or the Sai of the *kali yuga*, or an Ascent of this *sangam yuga*?

Whatever one may call this source, its Divinity was experienced by all in their hearts, in the clear elucidation of the *bhagavad-gītā*, as spoken through the Divine personification of Sadguru Sri Madhusudan Sai.

Key Messages

- *sanātana dharma* is unique because it allows for questioning, debating, arguing, examining, experiencing, and then accepting
- This *dharma* has perpetuated and sustained through the *guru śiṣya paramparā* for ages together
- In this *paramparā*, a *śiṣya* is allowed to question the *guru* provided he knows what he wants to learn, and surrenders to the *guru* completely; then asks the right kind of questions after having thought enough about it; renders service to the *guru* to win His grace; and then the *guru* gives His *upadeśa* – the nectar of the highest truth to the *śiṣya*
- It is only when Arjuna surrenders himself to Krishna as His śiṣya, does Krishna teach Arjuna through one of the best ways of teaching and learning – Questions and Answers

- *bhagavad-gītā* is the practical manual for life, and hence should be read while in the stage of *brahmacarya* itself, so that we learn about life, its purpose, and the right way of lead life
- It is the most authentic manual about life, creation and the creator, since the creator has expounded on these aspects Himself
- *bhagavad-gītā* is the essence of all the *upaniṣads*, which apart from elucidating on *brahma vidya*, also teaches how to attain it. Hence, it is also called as *yoga śāstra*
- *punarjanma* (reincarnations) and *karma* (consequences of actions) are the two basic principles of *sanātana dharma*. To understand these two concepts is important to understand the *bhagavad-gītā*



arjuna viṣadā yoga

• Sometimes it is the setbacks and failures in life that connects one back to God. Hence, in a way, sorrows and pains are also a form of *yoga*

sāṅkhya yoga

- Raise above the dualities of losses and gains, pleasures and pains
- Be steady and equanimous
- *stitha prajña* means steady consciousness. In this state, one is not affected by the happenings of the world, and this indeed is the highest state of human existence
- How to attain the state of *stitha prajña*? Be satisfied within yourself; have firm faith that whatever happens it is for good only
- Know that you are the *ātma*; you are not the body; you don't die; you are never born

karma yoga

- Enjoying or suffering the consequences of actions is the main reason for rebirth
- Action does not mean only physical; every thought, feeling, speaking and acting are all actions that will bear consequences. Hence, to know how to act becomes very important
- Act selflessly for the welfare of all to the best of your ability, offer it to God and do not worry about the results
- All actions are meant to purify the mind



Divine Consciousness - The Ability Behind Everything

jñāna karma saṅyāsa yoga

- Think about, 'who is the doer of an action, and who is the enjoyer of an action?'
- The *jīva* thinks that he is doing everything; but the truth is that the Divine only does everything
- The one who sees action in inaction and inaction in action is a *jñāni*
- The *jīva* is in truth Divine only and not different from Divine. Actions must be performed with this awareness
- The *jīva* is an instrument through which the Divine energy flows
- The attainment of *jñāna* alone will help to perform actions correctly and establish one in undisturbed peace
- 'I am not the doer; I am not the enjoyer' this is the ultimate truth
- The *ātman* or the Divine Consciousness is the ability behind everything. It is the power that gives us the ability to think, speak and act; yet it does not think, speak and act
- The mind with its *vāsanās* and *guņās* drives us to think, speak and act in a certain way
- By surrendering your mind totally to God, God will do everything and there is nothing that can go wrong

karma sanyāsa yoga

- Through the path of selfless actions, detached from doership and enjoyership, and unaffected by the fruits of the actions, yet completely involved in the action, one attains the status of *nitya sanyāsa*
- When actions are done like this, it purifies the mind, and in such a mind, *jñāna* dawns automatically
- A perfect jñāni will be a perfect karmayogi and a perfect karmayogi will be a perfect jñāni. No action ever binds them
- A true *jñāni* is the one who does not discriminate, differentiate, judge or hold any prejudices and preferences. He sees only the Divine in all
- Doing actions outside, and being established in the Self inside is the way to go about
- Perfection in *karma* is attained when we go about doing whatever we do selflessly without any attachment, aversion and anxiety
- Let your *karma* match with your *guṇa dharma*, so that you do it effortlessly

The Object

The Eye

dhyāna yoga

- After purifying the mind through *karma yoga*, it is important to steady the mind through *dhyāna yoga*
- *dhyāna* becomes *dhārana* when we focus on the same thought for a long time
- Where ever there is *śraddha*, *dhyāna* becomes easy
- An external object is seen by the eye, the eye is seen by the mind, the mind is seen by the *ātman* or the *sākṣi*. To be established in the *ātman* is *dhyāna*
- The practice of discriminating and distancing yourself from the mind will bestow peace immediately
- Focus on the middle of the brow and constantly be aware of your true identity, which is Divinity. This helps in complete detachment and constant centeredness

jñāna vijñāna yoga

- Lord Krishna says "I am the manifest as well as the unmanifest Supreme energy. I am the brilliance of the sun, the taste in water, the buddhi and the prāņa or life breath in humans." The same energy pervades everything
- The prakruti with its five gross elements and subtle elements like mind, intelligence and ego, are also His manifestation, through His māyā
- *vijñāna* means to know that God is everywhere and in everything in the form of energy
- This energy is conscious and aware, and has got its own intelligence. It gives the property of water to water, and fire to fire
- The supreme divine consciousness permeates and pervades everything. No place, no space, no object is bereft of it

Every time you lose faith in God, smell that first fragrance of rain that falls on the earth and you'll know there is God. Everywhere there is God and God alone is. Everything else is just manifestations of the same God.

Develop this vision and you will be ever happy; you will never be lost to God; God will be never lost to you because everywhere you are surrounded by God.

akşara brahma yoga

- The one who identify themselves with their true identity as Divinity itself will reach their ultimate abode while breathing their last breath. Hence it is extremely important that we constantly live in truth, since we do not know when our end might come
- Only if we live correctly, we will also be able to die correctly
- All the time, at all places, keep thinking about God, keep contemplating about Divinity
- Think of Divinity constantly, do everything for His sake, be a *jīvan mukta*, and ultimately finish this game of life never to be caught again in the cycle of birth and death

The most important thing is what you are doing with yourself today. Are you living your life in accordance with the Divine will? Are you completely in tune with the divinity within and without? If 'yes', you are ever ready. This confidence comes to us when we are ever ready.



rāja vidya rāja guhya yoga

- This world is only an illusion which seems to exist on the substratum of pure divine consciousness. This is similar to seeing the snake on a rope, wherein the snake is only an illusion
- The world that we experience is because of God, however the world does not really exist. Only God exists
- Just like how snake is an imagination, the world and its happiness and sorrow are only an imagination and not real
- Just like how only the rope exists in the imaginary snake, similarly it is only Divinity or consciousness that exists in the imaginary world



- In other words, the world appears to be existing on Consciousness, but the truth is only Consciousness exists
- Everything that exists is because of God, yet God does not exist in these, because what seem to exist actually does not exist
- The world with all its characters is only a dream and not real
- Seeing only the Divine consciousness in everything is real wisdom

vibhūti yoga

- The ability to experience everything is because of consciousness. He is the eye of the eye, ear of the ear, speech behind our speech, and mind of the mind
- The mind which is born out of Divinity, is itself the reason for obstructing the complete expression of divinity
- The purer our mind is, Divinity expresses there in all its splendour
- Practice discriminating the real from the unreal and attach your mind to the real (Divinity) constantly
- Though He is in everything, He manifests best in all those that are pure and perfect
- See God, know God and thank God in every situation

viśwarūpa darśana yoga

- To see Divinity everywhere is the real *viśwarūpa darśana*
- Once we experience that God only pervades everything, our ego dissolves and delusion disappears
- *ananya bhakti* or *vikampa bhakti* or love for God alone makes one deserving for such an experience. Only the grace of a *guru* or Divine can give this ultimate experience
- Just be an instrument of God. He will do everything through you
- Consider God as your everything Father, Mother, Friend, and Beloved. Develop this kind of *bhakti*. This will ultimately help you see God everywhere

bhakti yoga

- God only expects your pure unconditional love and nothing else
- God's love is so pure and elevating, unlike the worldly love
- Anything done with pure love for God becomes perfect and immortal
- Supreme devotion for the Divine is the highest *dharma* of every human
- Worshipping the form and name of God is the easiest to begin with. This will gradually lead to releasing the Divine as the formless and nameless
- Keep your mind completely absorbed in God if this is difficult, through *abhyāsa yoga* keep bringing your mind back to God—if this is also tough, do everything for the sake of the Divine alone and give up attachment to the fruits of your actions
- A true *bhakta* will neither trouble others nor be troubled by others
- A true *bhakta* develops acceptance towards every situation and peacefully addresses it without reacting, but responding
- A true *bhakta* is in the state of complete surrender to God, without any ego and attachment



kșetra and kșetrajña

kșetra kșetrajña vibhāga yoga

- The pancamahābhūtās, the karmendriyās, jñānendriyās, manas, buddhi, cittā, ahankāra are all the kṣetra. These are the modifications of the Divine
- The Divine is the *kṣetrajña* which is a witness to everything including the mind
- The *kṣetrajña* is the ability to experience everything, but it is beyond all experiences
- The *kṣetrajña* is always constant and changeless, unlike the *kṣetra*
- The *kṣetrajña* is the same in all, and by this way we are all connected

guņatrayavibhāga yoga

- The three fundamental qualities (*guņās*) that shape human thoughts, behaviour and perceptions are *sattva* (goodness), *rajas* (passion), and *tamas* (ignorance)
- *sattva* leads to clarity, wisdom, and balanced actions. *rajas* fuels desires, attachment, and restless pursuits. *tamas* results in confusion, inertia, and darkness
- Aligning with *sattva* and gradually diminishing the dominance of *rajas* and *tamas*, elevates our consciousness and moves us closer to Self-realisation
- Ultimately, transcending the *guṇās* makes us one with the Supreme

- The metaphor of an eternal tree has roots above and branches below. This symbolises the system of the world, which has its origins in the Divine, and its manifestations in the material realm
- Recognising the distinction between the eternal consciousness (*puruṣa*) and the transient material world (*prakṛuti*) leads to profound transformation. This insight awakens a special intelligence that allows one to discern their true nature and detach from the illusory aspects of existence

- sāttvic food is pure and it nourishes the body and mind; rājasic food is spicy, overly salty, and it causes restlessness and craving; tāmasic food is stale, impure, and obtained through unethical means, and it causes lethargy and confusion
- *sāttvic* sacrifice is that which is performed selflessly, with pure intentions, and without expecting any returns. *rājasic* sacrifice is driven by personal gain and recognition. *tāmasic* sacrifice is performed improperly without any proper consideration and faith

- - Cultivate *sāttvic* qualities and actions to progress on the spiritual path with purity, selflessness, and disciplined devotion

mokṣa saṅyāsa yoga

These hospitals provide quality free healthcare services to rural dwellers. Both the hospitals offer a wide range of paediatric and maternal healthcare services, while also treating children and adults from all age groups. In the month of June 2023, the following services were provided:

- Outpatient consultations were conducted for 497 children and 680 adults

From I to We to He – The Unfolding Path of my Inner Journey

🦰 angita Naidu works for the Queensland Government in Australia. She has a \bigvee Masters in Education and is currently pursuing a Ph.D. on Swami's command. She also has an Advanced Diploma in Values Education from the Sathya Sai Institute of Thailand. She has been involved in values education for the past 25 years and is passionate about teacher development as a role model in values education, and helps in India and Australia with various projects. Her husband, Sunil Naidu is one of the Directors of the Heart of Love Centre for Human Development in Australia and also started the 'Health in Kind Foundation' as directed by Sadguru. Their son, Sai Kishan has joined the Sri Sathya Sai Loka Seva Gurukulum. Sadguru in one of his speeches said, "I brought Sunil from New Zealand to Australia to do my work. While Sunil looks after 'Health', Sangita looks after 'Education.""

There is a saying just before you enter the building, Sai Dham in Muddenahalli which says, *"Those who work for God, become God."* This is my path.

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Three great teachers or Gurus – Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba, Dr Jumsai and Sadguru Sri Madhusudan Sai guided, lifted and inspired me into taking my inner journey. As I grew up, these three *gurus* appeared at different times, when I needed them the most, and enabled me to take a step closer to my Self, to be moulded into a perfect instrument in His Hands.



Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba

My story begins as a child praying at the altar in my house, where my mother had placed an old black and white photo of a man with fuzzy hair amidst other Gods and Goddesses, and I used to wonder who He was. My mother had told me His name was Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba, and that she had taken the picture out of a book she had come across, where she was teaching and she still has the black and white photograph of Baba for the last 60 years. That is all I knew of Him at that stage.

I was born in Fiji. I adored Lord Jesus from being in a Christian Primary School, where I attended Bible courses and sang glories of God, and longed to join Mother Teresa's mission at the time. However, my parents had other ideas. So, when I was sixteen, I received a scholarship to study in New Zealand. The night before my flight, I sighted, what looked like the corner of a card in the wall of our house; so, I pulled it out like a visiting card—it was a colour photograph of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba, under which was written "Do not depend on others to serve your personal needs, become your own servant, before proceeding to serve others", and that message became my guiding principle on my journey away from home.



I began attending the Sathya Sai Centre in Auckland and learnt of Bal Vikas classes held on Sunday mornings and Thursdays. Herein, started my journey of conducting values classes, which I prepared for during the week, memorised the ślokās and taught the little children on Sundays. I also joined the Youth Group and attended study groups on the upanisads, followed by the bhagavad-gītā on Wednesday evenings. We also participated in leadership training run by Lt Gen Dr Chibber, who wrote 'The Mahavakya of Leadership.' Our youth leader was a lecturer who helped at the Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning in India and Sathya Sai Baba told him to bring the youth of New Zealand for His birthday in 1994.

It was November 1994, that I joined a group of youth on my first trip to meet Sathya Sai Baba.







The first time I saw Him in physical form was in the Poorna Chandra Hall. He was as majestic as I had imagined, full of love and His energy went straight into my Heart. He sang, '*satyam jñanam anantam brahma*' and I was in total bliss. On that trip, lasting six weeks, He granted us many interviews and spoke at length to us about food, knowledge, spirituality, three types of teachers – one who complains, one who explains and one who inspires etc.

I was married before I went on that first trip. My husband, Sunil was born into a Sai family. In their house in Fiji, *vibhuti* or holy ashes used to appear on the pictures of Bhagawan Baba. Bhajans were held in their house on Fridays. He had also attended Bal Vikas classes, with his three brothers, and his father was involved in values education then. Swami had brought us together, as he also got a scholarship for the same school as I did, in New Zealand.

After our first trip, we visited Swami's abode every year for the Christmas programme, and also assisted and participated in various World and Youth conferences. In fact, when we went in 1995, we had the desire to stay for good. Swami asked when we were having a child. He told us to go back as He has some work for us. Our life continued in His service, where I got more involved in Values Education and Sunil in various leadership and service projects. We moved to Australia after some time, as Sunil's father was unwell and had moved to Sydney.

My Second Teacher - Dr Jumsai

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Sathya Sai Baba led me to Dr Jumsai, who was the second teacher to inspire me through to the next phase of transformation, as He also embodied 'To Be, To Do, and To Tell' leadership model. While in New Zealand, I attended a Values Education teacher training session by Loraine Burrows from Thailand, and this had a deep impact on me. She had mentioned about Dr Jumsai, who had started the Sathya Sai Institute and School in Thailand. It so happened that Dr Jumsai visited Australia and his talks on Values resonated with my heart, as I found him to be a role model in Values. Thus, I ended up at the Thailand school, which was about living in a Gurukulum environment and learning by being around the Guru, Dr Jumsai. I learnt that we cannot teach Values through words, we teach by **Being the Value**, as students learn from 'who we are than what we say.' It was Love that transformed me, and I needed a lot of it. I learnt that love transformed the students and I understood the importance of unity of head, heart, and hands. I found that immense LOVE in Sathya Sai Baba and again in Dr Jumsai.

The Sathya Sai School in Thailand was for me, 'Love in Action.' The students would run to Dr Jumsai as he arrived at the gate of the school such was his love. There were times when children used to see Sathya Sai Baba walking into the school (visions). Sathya Sai Baba once appeared in a class as I was teaching the students a song for His birthday. There was much to learn from being with the students—experiences during meditation, stories, and values songs every day in the morning and evening, planting rice with students in the rice paddies, witnessing miracles in Buddhist temples, and participating in community service with the students. After three months, I completed my Diploma in Values Education and received the medal and certificate from Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba's hands in Puttaparthi. I wished to stay longer in Thailand by His Grace, so I decided to do an Advanced Diploma, which involved research work and a thesis, and to receive another medal from Swami's Divine Hands! Sunil also joined me in Thailand, as was His Divine will. Dr Jumsai asked Sunil to do the Diploma course, where Sunil presented on leadership and management in Values education and returned to Sydney. We both had our graduation in Puttaparthi, from Swami's hands in 2001.

Inspired by the Values Education and the love of the students in Thailand, I completed a Bachelor of Education with Honours from the University of Sydney and went on to teach at the Sathya Sai School in Murwillumbah, Australia. We also bought land in Murwillumbah, as an inner voice kept prompting me till we had got the land. Incidentally, when Sadguru visited the house in 2017, He explained how He had instrumented the purchase and built the house on that land. Sadguru had told us which room was His when we had shown Him the initial plans. In addition, Sadguru provided a large 'Sri Yantra' and told me where to put it in the house, when it was completed. We had moved to the Gold Coast by then for Sunil's work. He had been very sick, had healed through Swami's grace, and dedicated his life to Swami.

We continued to visit Sathya Sai Baba every year when He would ask every time – where is our son? Then in 2008, almost 15 years after Swami had said, "have a son", He blessed Sunil and me with Sai Kishan. I left work to be with Sai Kishan as Swami had taught us that children need their mothers when there are young. We took him to see Swami when he was 18 months old and Swami blessed him by saying 'very happy'. That was the last time we had darshan of His physical form.

We were deeply at a loss when Sathya Sai Baba left His physical frame as we wanted Sai Kishan to experience His Divine presence the way we had. We also moved to Brisbane, after our last trip to Puttaparthi, as Sunil's mother lived there and his father had passed away, and, also for Sai Kishan's school. Sai Kishan loves music, so he attended Piano and guitar lessons, plus choir classes after school. He would play piano for hours at home, so we would often do bhajans/songs together. However, we missed the Divine presence of Sathya Sai Baba. I now realise why He was born after so long, as Swami wanted Sai Kishan to be with Him at this stage of the mission.

Sadguru Sri Madhusudan Sai

In 2014, we attended a Satsang in Murwillumbah, where Sadguru Sri Madhusudan came for the first time. And as soon as He spoke, I had no doubt that Sadguru Sri Madhusudan Sai was my Guru after Sathya Sai Baba had left His physical form. Sadguru spoke of many things that only Sathya Sai would know and had said in our personal interviews. At that Satsang, He held Sai Kishan's hand and walked with him to the front of the gathering of youth. We experienced Sadguru's omnipresence when He had mentioned in a gathering that Sai Kishan was sharing his food at school and his mother was asking why was he doing it. He also materialised a chain with Sathya Sai Baba embedded in a locket for Sai Kishan, when he sang, 'Love is God.' Sai Kishan sang the same song, 'Love, Love, Love is God', a few times, in Singapore, Japan, Kodaikanal, and Australia. He had said then, Sai Kishan would join his school one day.

Another incident happened in September 2017, when Sadguru visited Australia and came for a brief visit to His house that we had built. He materialised a Radha-Krishna necklace for me. I remembered that years ago, a couple of Hare Krishna devotees had visited our house in Fiji to sell some books and pictures, and my father had bought a large painting of Radha Krishna from them, which he had framed and placed in our lounge. Whenever I sat there, I would gaze at the beauty of Radha Krishna and chant the Mahamantra written under the picture – 'Hare Rama Hare Rama, Hare Krishna, Hare Krishna, Krishna, Krishna Hare Hare.' Hence, when Sadguru gave the necklace to me, He showed His Omnipresence again.

In an interview in March 2017, in Japan, Sadguru asked me to study further, which I am currently doing, while working as well. He also asked both Sunil and me to speak on Values Education in Singapore in 2015 and then invited us to Japan with Him on two occasions, where He talked to a few of us about the Teacher Education Programme. Our life continues in Values education and service, as His instruments, to do as He wills. At another Satsang in Australia, when Sadguru asked Sunil to speak, He said that "*I had brought Him to New Zealand, then to Australia to do my work.*" So, the lines on our hands have been drawn by Him only, to take us where He knows is best.

I am inspired and grateful every single day for what Sadguru Sri Madhusudan Sai says, what He does, and how He does everything. Millions of lives have benefitted from His work, and He is a living example of selflessness and perfection. Last year, Sadguru asked Sai Kishan to join the school in Muddenahalli in one year. This school year, Sai Kishan was told to come and join the Sri Sathya Sai Loka Seva Gurukulum without any possessions, as all students of all the campuses received everything from toothbrushes to uniforms to basic needs. By this He is teaching us, "All are ONE family" which resonates within His institutions. He provides and takes care of everything; He says we just need to surrender to Him.

I feel most blessed at being able to attend the *bhagavad-gītā* sessions this July, in His Divine presence. Each day of the Gita session has been tremendously enlightening. Sadguru has patiently taken us step by step to understand 'how to live in this world and beyond'. Bhakti Yoga has been my favourite, as I long to be Radha when He is Krishna.

I am grateful that this life has been given a purpose by Sadguru. My only prayer is that each person reading this comes to understand His profound message and realises his or her True self, to serve in whatever capacity they can, and to become Him. I am eternally grateful to Sathya Sai Baba, Dr Art-Ong Jumsai, and Sadguru Sri Madhusudan Sai for paving this life's pathway. I know that without Sadguru's grace and guidance at this juncture, my life would have lost its true purpose. All I have written is not enough to describe everything that Sadguru embodies and keeps doing out of His concern and Love for us -I pray to be of service till my last breath, "to Be His Flute", and to reach the goal of selflessness in this journey.
